Terms and Conditions

Aim of the Club

- To encourage and promote watersports.
- To provide and maintain equipment for the use of club members.
- To organise local watersports and social events.
- To actively promote safety on the water.

Conditions of Use of Facilities and Equipment (Rules of the Club)

- The membership year runs from date of payment of club fees for the following year.
- A register of members will be kept containing the name, addresses, and contact details. These details will be used by the club only and will not be passed on to any other parties except British Water Ski.
- The management may terminate the membership of a member of the club if his/her subscription (if any) has not been paid within 14 days after such subscription shall become due, in which event he/she shall be readmitted to membership only upon re-election and on payment of arrears, unless a satisfactory reason is given
- The management or their appointed representative shall have the power to reprimand any member or to suspend or expel from membership any member who shall act in breach of the rules or regulations of the club, or whose conduct shall be prejudicial to the interests of Brighton Wakeboard Club or its members or which in the opinion of the management render him/her unfit for membership.
- Guests may be admitted to the club at the discretion of the management.
- The word "BOAT" when used in these rules shall be deemed to be one that is suitable for towing a water-skier.
- Advice about how to ski and improve is given on a non-professional basis and it is the responsibility of each individual to decide if they wish to follow that advice.
- Life jackets must be worn at all times when skiing. Children and adults who cannot swim must wear life jackets in the boat at all times.
- The club shall consist of honorary members, full members, junior members, and student members. Full members must be of eighteen years or older, junior members must be under eighteen years but over sixteen years and have the written consent of their parent or guardian, student members must provide proof of eligibility for discount.
- The management are empowered to elect persons who have been of exceptional service to the club as honorary members.
- The management shall from time to time make, repeal and amend bye laws and rules as they shall think expedient for the management and well being of the club.
- It shall be the duty of every member to take available means to put a stop to any infringement of the rules or bye laws coming under their notice, and report them to the management.
- All members shall have a regard for the British Water Ski safety recommendations and in general act in a safe and responsible manner.
- All boats must have a competent ski boat driver on board and in charge and all boats towing wakeboarders/waterskiers must have an observer on board.
- It is a condition of registration that all privately owned boats must be insured at the owner's expense against third party and passenger risks for a minimum of £1,000,000.
- All registered boats must clearly display the club name which will be issued to all members on registration.
- Users that ignore the advice of Brighton Wakeboard Club regarding use of our equipment will find themselves liable for all damage caused to Brighton Wakeboard Club's equipment and all costs incurred
- Users should check their equipment or, equipment provided to them by Brighton Wakeboard Club to ensure that it is seaworthy. Any defects should be reported to Brighton Wakeboard Club immediately and replacement equipment found before going out on the water.
- Users should at all times show care and consideration to other users out at sea and observe all requirements of other relevant bodies(including the local Council and the Coast guard)
- Under -16's are not permitted to engage in watersports or use any of the Club's equipment.

Declaration

I understand and declare that, as conditions of acceptance and membership that:

The club accepts no responsibility for injury or damage sustained by any person or to a persons property during club activities or whilst on club premises. I/my family ski at my/our own risk and in the event of an accident do not hold responsible and no claim can be put on Brighton Wakeboard Club or the person driving the boat or the observer.

Users accept full responsibility for their own safety and for any loss or damage to any equipment which they may have borrowed from Brighton Wakeboard Club and agree to indemnify and hold harmless Brighton Wakeboard Club from and against all liabilities, losses, damages, costs, charges and expenses in relation thereto.

I/We have insurance cover, covering any third party whilst I/we are participating in Water Skiing or water borne activities at Brighton Wakeboard Club
